





Chemical Leasing – a performance-based business model developed by the United Nations Industrial Development Organization (UNIDO) with support from the Austrian government, to promote sustainable chemicals management. Instead of selling chemicals by volume, suppliers sell the function or service that the chemical provides, such as cleaning or coating

The approach encourages more efficient use of chemicals, reducing waste and environmental impact







Launched in 2004 with support from the Austrian government, UNIDO's Global Chemical Leasing Programme, it aligns with several Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs), including promoting sustainable industrialization and fostering innovation.

The initiative has gained international recognition and support, with countries like Germany, Switzerland, Peru, and Sri Lanka joining the effort.

UNIDO's Global Chemical Leasing Programme contributes to the UN Sustainable Development Agenda 2030 and addresses in particular SDG 9, "Build resilient infrastructure, promote inclusive and sustainable industrialization and foster innovation", which is embedded in the UNIDO mandate.

It also relates directly to the SDGs 3, 6, 12 and 13.

The initiative was designed fully in line with SAICM principles, aiming to contribute to the Circular Economy movement.





Today, more than twenty years later, there is no doubt that the performance-based business model, Chemical Leasing, can build the business case for sustainable chemical management by creating win-win situations for business partners and the environment.

Built on strong cooperation between partners and based on mutual trust, chemical leasing

- increases the efficient use of chemicals
- reduces the risks to human health brought about by their use,
- improves the economic and environmental performance of participating companies and ultimately
- enhances business performance.
